As of Monday 18 November, ALL of our students will receive a pack of UHT milk pack each Monday to Thursday in class.

The programme continues for the rest of 2013 and again into 2014.

The children will be taught about the benefits of drinking milk over the next two weeks and how to recycle the tetra packs that the milk comes in.

This is very important because Bailey Road School will consume over 400 milk packs per 1,600 per week, 16,000 per term and around 64,000 milk packs per year. We do not want any litter left around our school or in our community.
