Our hosts will be the Year 3-4 Karaka team.



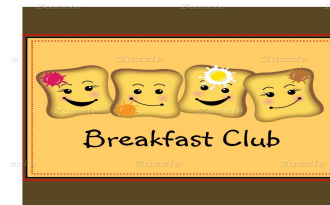
