Bailey Road School received 12 candidate nominations for our 2016-2019 Board of Trustees. The nominees are:

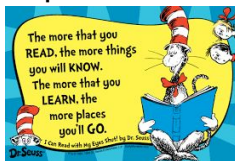

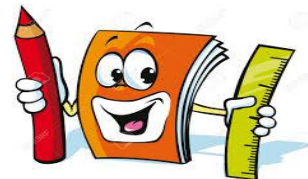

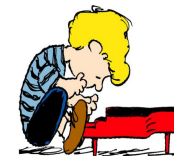


Bailey Road School's Got Talent:
