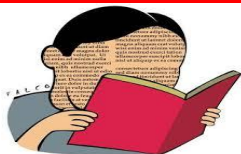
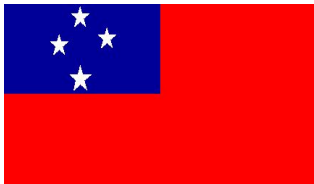

## Congratulations:

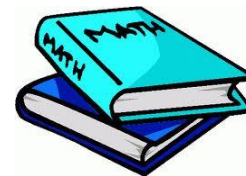
