

CURIOSITY, PURPOSE & WONDER (CPW) Learning at BAILEY ROAD



At Bailey Road School we love CPW learning and use a model called 'TEACH' across our school. There are five distinct phases within the model and the purpose of this whanau information newsletter is to begin to explain how students use the different phases and what you can do at home

to support their learning. By the end of the year you will have all the newsletters and a great understanding of TEACH model we use.

Tune in

The first phase of TEACH is 'Tune in'. This is when we get excited about the learning to come and find out what is already known.

We have a 'Hook In' as part of this to have some fun together and begin thinking about the CPW.

EXPLORE

Explore is the second phase of the TEACH model. This is where students have time to be curious and clarify their ideas while working with others. It is important to ask 'Is what I think I know true?' Time for discussion or conversation that also has disagreement helps answer this question.

You can help your child in their CPW by asking;

- What is the inquiry this term?
- What is the schoolwide question?

You can help even more by sharing your ideas and offering alternative viewpoints to assist your child in thinking more deeply. Experiences, books and shared viewing of some websites on the inquiry are wonderful ways to support your child's learning.
