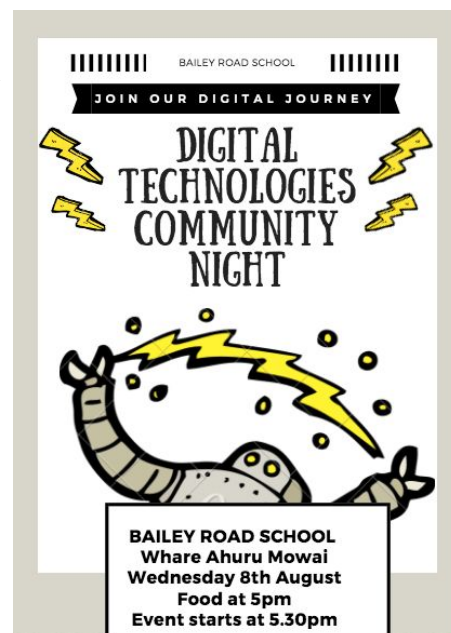

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## PARK SAFELY AND KEEP OUR KIDS SAFE

This term our school is participating in Auckland Transport's 'Safety at the School Gate' programme. This will involve visits from Parking Officers before and after school, who will help us keep our tamariki safe by monitoring how we drop off, pick up and park our cars around the school.
