If your child is turning five during 2019 and you wish for them to attend our school please do come into the school office and get the enrolment forms to fill out.



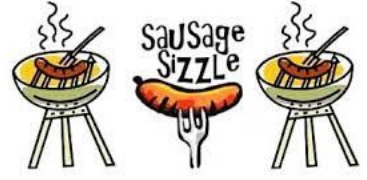
