They found it interactive and informative with some key information to remember:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Using the voice 90% of the time will stop the attack</i> • <i>Use a deep, loud tone of voice</i> • <i>Shout "Don't touch me"</i> • <i>Ready stance, kick for the shin/knee with toe up and knee bent</i> • <i>Quick movement so they don't know it's coming</i>
