LOCKDOWN PROCEDURES

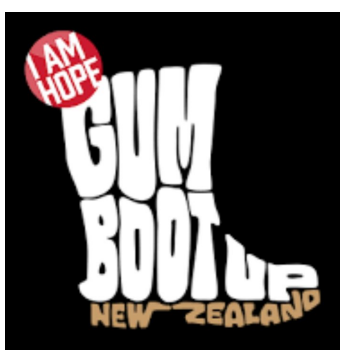


GUMBOOT UP THIS FRIDAY

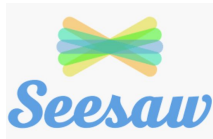
