RIMU CAMP 2026

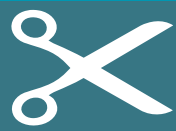

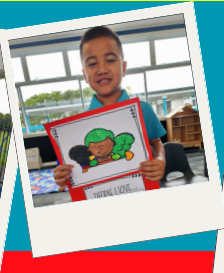

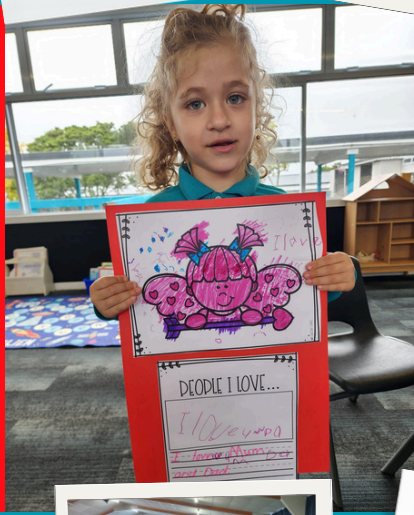
Kowhai Team
