

# COVID PLAN OF ACTION

What will happen should there be a positive case at Bailey Road School

## COMMUNICATION AND ACTION

1. The Principal is contacted by the Ministry of Health about a positive case at BRS
2. All BRS Whānau will be notified of the situation and the school's action by Seesaw and Skool Loop
3. Following COVID health and safety guidelines we will identify and isolate close contacts, which may be groups or even an individual student
4. Only Whānau affected as close contacts will be contacted via text or phone asking them to collect their child/ren and take a COVID test
5. Bailey Road School will remain open for learning
6. Students or Staff who were close contacts, must produce evidence from the Ministry of Health, that they can return to school

## GROUPS - CLASSES - INDIVIDUALS

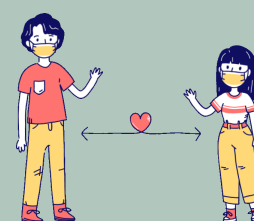
Close contacts @ BRS - families contacted by text or phone
