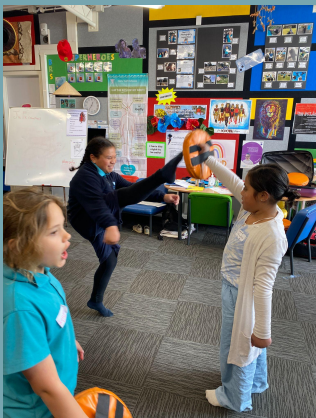
We are all looking forward to fantastic fine weather in term four and look forward to getting our swimming programmes up and running when it gets a bit warmer.

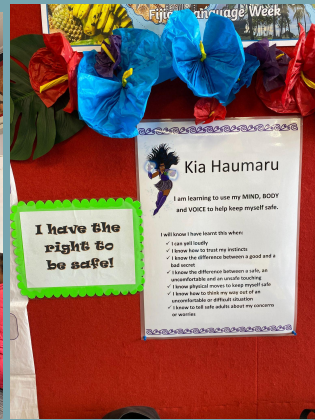
It is great to see everyone back and ready for another exciting term at Bailey Road School.
