The move to Level One will bring a few changes in how we continue to maintain health and safety at Bailey Road School.

## Key points for Level One:

- the main office gate will be the entry for before school care (3oclockdash) and students arriving from 8.00am - 8.30am
- the only students onsite before 8.00am, will at before school care (3oclockdash)
- breakfast club will be in the SWiS office for Week 1, from 8.00-8.25am
- other gates will be opened at 8.30am
- all gates will be locked by 9.00am, then reopened for pick up at 2.30pm
- during school hours, parents and visitors will need to be signed in as per our Health and Safety procedures
- gates will be locked at the end of the day (3.00pm)
- regular hand washing will continue
- coughing/sneezing into elbows will be expected
- any students or staff who are sick, should stay at home
- QR code for the NZ COVID Tracer app is on display in the office, hall and junior gate
