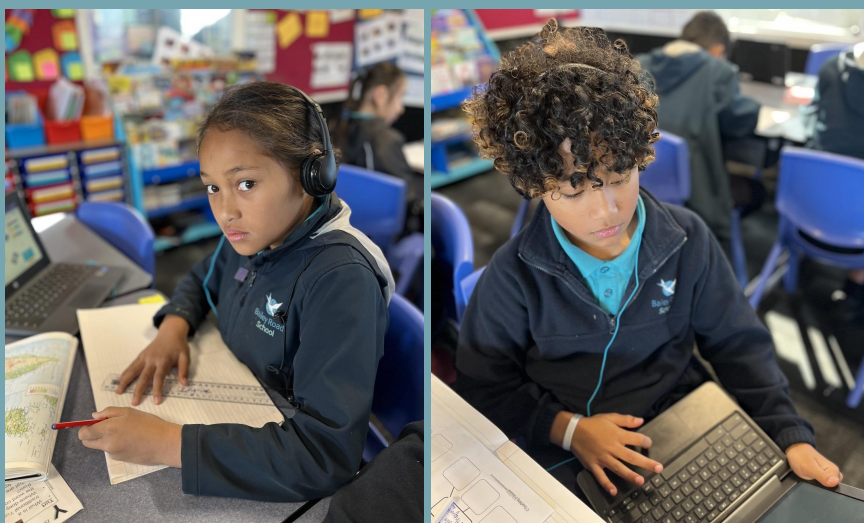
Mid year reports will be sent out next week and we are happy to share the progress your tamariki have made. At this halfway point we feel poised to make great learning gains for the rest of the year.
