- 5] **World class inclusive public education** New Zealand education is trusted and sustainable.


The NELPs are statutory documents enabled by the Education and Training Act [2020] that set out the government's priorities for education. Seven priorities operate under the objectives, giving further detail to the NELPs. This link provides more information on how the NELPs inform the way the school operates. We will publish the NELPs on our website too so that they are an easy reference tool for you.

Last Friday we took our whole school trip to Long Bay. Our students have shown extraordinary resilience and exhibited our HEART values, particularly 'Togetherness' during these difficult times, over the past few years. Visiting the beach is a fun activity that we used as a writing prompt, an opportunity to look at seaside ecosystems and as a chance to promote health and PE through Sunsmart awareness and ocean swimming.

DONATIONS PLEASE


