### *A word from the Principal – Mr Kelly.....*

Tēnā koutou,

The year [and what a year it has been] is coming to a close. It is time to reflect and consider what the future offers Bailey Road School. Part of our reflection process is gathering end of year academic and social data and to analyse this when making decisions about next year's programmes. I will send information to our whānau via Seesaw providing a snapshot of our school at the end of the year, 2020.

At this time of the year our staff, students and community feedback inform my development of our annual plan for 2021. This plan will be available on our website in early 2021 for you to view if you wish to. The annual plan looks at our three year Strategic Plan and reviews progress, as well as making changes or adding previously unknown opportunities to the plan. Next year we are looking at a number of ways to enhance what we already achieve - the most significant of these is our focus on delivering a localised curriculum. Behind such a nondescript sentence are a large number of initiatives that have Bailey Road staff and students working together in different ways to achieve improved outcomes in 2021.

As is mentioned in this newsletter, Bailey Road School is one of the lucky recipients of the Healthy School Lunches programme. This means that lunches will be provided to our students every day next year, from the first day of school. 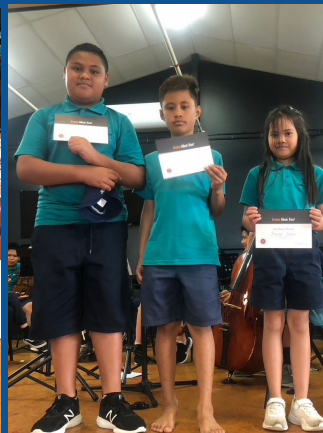
